ZWEIGELT VOM HEIDEBODEN

Grape: Zweigelt, which is a clone of St. Laurent and Blaufraenkisch.

Tasting Notes: An Austrian specialty, this wine goes well with poultry, venison, lasagna, and aged cheeses.

ZWEIGELT VON den HUEGELN

Grape: Zweigelt

Tasting Notes: Saturated, brilliant purple hue. Perfumed berry and mineral aromas. A lush entry leads to a rounded, supple, medium-bodied palate. A silky stylish red, with a well cut finish.

NIT'ANA

Grape: Zweigelt, Blaufrankisch, Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah

Tasting Notes: "Nit'ana" means "not made from one variety". With its bouquet of ripe berry fruits, gentle spices and pleasant toastiness, this fine garnet-red wine is most appealing. On the palate it is powerful and velvety with well-structured tannins and a long, persistent finish.

PINOT NOIR/ ZWEIGELT SPAETLESE

Grape: Pinot Noir and Zweigelt

Tasting Notes: Bright chimney orange; fresh fruits like blackberry on the nose. Seductive bouquet; on the palate very elegant and balanced, integrated residual sweetness; fruity finish.

ZWEIGELT BEERENAUSLESE

Grape: Zweigelt

Tasting Notes: bright chimney red in color with a nose of fresh strawberry and a seductive bouquet. Very elegant and balanced palate with a nice residual sweetness, complex and light with an intensely fruity aftertaste.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Grape: Sauvignon Blanc

Tasting Notes: medium yellow; slightly herbaceous on the nose, traces of apple and gooseberry; the palate is marked by juicy fruit, racy structure, displaying white gooseberry and fresh mineral aromas ending with lovely citrus notes.

PREMIUM EISWEIN

Grape: Gruner Veltliner

Tasting Notes: Brilliant yellow hue, exotic and floral aromas. A sharp entry leads to a medium-bodied palate with pure fruit flavors. Sweetness is balanced by vibrant acidity. Pure and intense.

RIESLING BEERENAUSLESE

Grape: Riesling

Tasting Notes: Deep yellow-golden hue. Focused, concentrated and firmly structured. Packed with apricot, honey and lime aromas and flavors that don't budge, following right through to the long finish. Serve with pancakes, Christmas pudding, light chocolate cakes like "Sacher Torte" and cheese.

PREMIUM BEERENAUSLESE

Grape: Chardonnay 50% Samling 25% and Welschriesling 25%

Tasting Notes: Pure peach and tropical fruit aromas are well defined. A rich entry leads to a sweet, medium-bodied palate with balanced acidity. Intensely fruity. A fresh, lovely style.

RIESLING TROCKENBEERENAUSLESE

Grape: Riesling

Tasting Notes: Honey, citrus and pastry flavors. Well-balanced and ending with a long aftertaste of butterscotch and orange peel

PREMIUM TROCKENBEERENAUSLESE

Grape: Chardonnay and Pinot Blanc

Tasting Notes: Deep, brilliant yellow-golden hue. Subdued, tropical fruit aromas. A rich entry leads to a very sweet, moderately full bodied palate with a nervy edge of acidity.
